

PEYOTE STITCH PATTERN

Flowering vine

- DB0113 Transparent blue luster
- DB0917 Sparkle turquoise green-lined topaz
- DB0182 Silver-lined jade green
- DB0124 Transparent golden olive luster
- DB0280 Cranberry-lined crystal luster
- DB0874 Matte opaque red AB
- DB0875 Matte opaque mauve AB
- DB0694 Dyed semi-matte silver-lined purple
- DB0042 Silver-lined gold
- DB0200 White

This pattern is worked in flat odd-count peyote stitch (How-Tos). Start by picking up the beads in the second and third rows; later you can go back and add the first row with the tail. The finished beadwork measures 5¾ in. (14.6 cm) without the clasp.

To complete the bracelet, I attached 40 mm Toob findings: Square stitch (How-Tos) a cylinder over all but the first and last two up-beads on each end of the bracelet. Slide a Toob finding over each square stitch row, and use chainnose pliers to close the end flaps. Then use 5 mm jump rings to attach two toggle clasps. Toob findings from Bead Cats, beadcats.com.
